 - FCE and CAE from Cambridge Main Suite Exams with a minimum score of 154 (<https://www.cambridgeenglish.org/exams-and-tests/>)

Only EPT UI/ITP TOEFL/IELTS/FCE/CAE certificates obtained from May 2023 onward are considered valid. If you have received or will receive a degree from an institution where English is the primary language of instruction, you do not need to submit an English language proficiency certificate. Instead, you must provide a letter from your institution confirming that English is the primary language of instruction.
6. Indonesian language proficiency certificate of one of the following:
 - TIBA with a minimum score of 4
 - UKBI with a minimum score of 482
 - TIBA/UKBI certificate is a mandatory document, except for those who have received a degree from an institution where Indonesian is the primary language of instruction.
 - BIPA course certificate from Lembaga Bahasa Internasional, Fakultas Ilmu Pengetahuan Budaya, Universitas Indonesia (LBI FIB UI) with a minimum level of 3. You can use this certificate if you do not have an Indonesian language proficiency certificate, or you have not received a high school or equivalent school certificate from an institution where Indonesian is the primary language of instruction
7. Health certificate.

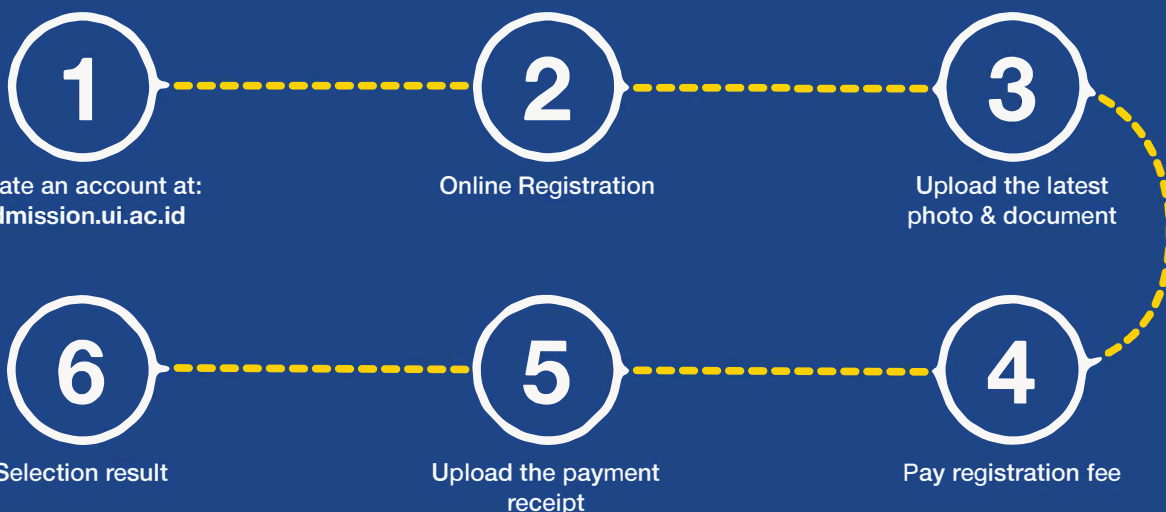
