

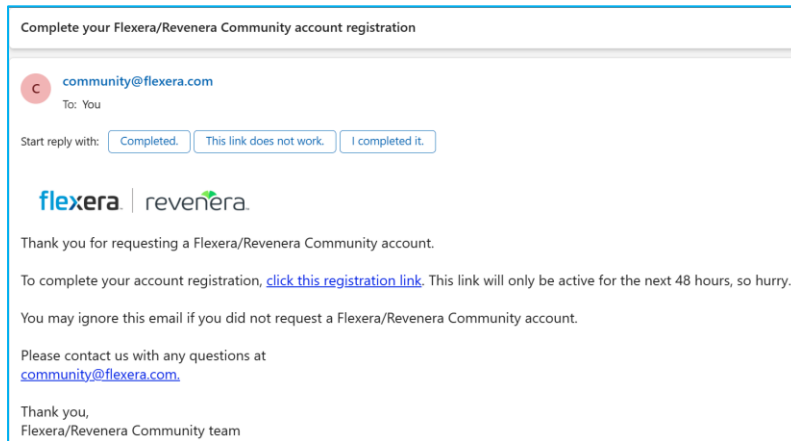
Please use your **corporate email address**. Once submitted you will receive an email with a registration link.




Step 3
