# TIMBER MINI QUILT

*Finished Size 18" x 24"*

## SUPPLIES

Steam a Seam Lite 2, or the fusible material of your choice.

Background fabric: 20" x 26"

Backing fabric: 22" x 28"

Fabric for trees: 1/8 yard of eight prints from Forest Floor by Bonnie Christine for Art Gallery Fabrics

Binding: 1/3 yard fabric

Aurifil 50 wt. threads to coordinate with your fabrics.

Build your fabric for the tree appliqué as follows:

1. Cut a 2" square from one of your fabrics. Using a different fabric, cut a strip to be sewn to one side of the square. The strip does not have to be a rectangle and may have angles on the sides. It should be about 3" long to allow the ends of the strip to extend beyond the square. After stitching the two pieces together, press the seam allowance open and trim both ends even with the square's edges.
2. Using another fabric, sew an additional strip to any side. Always allow the strip to be a little longer than necessary in order to trim the edges even. Press all seam allowances open.
3. Keep building your fabric, keeping in mind that you will need a finished piece approximately 10" x 20" for your tree appliqué. When you have reached that size, press well. See Figure 1.
4. Trace the tree designs on the paper of the fusible material.
5. Fuse in place on the back side of the pieced fabric.
6. Cut out on the drawn lines.
7. Referring to the picture of the finished quilt, fuse in place on the background fabric.
8. Using Aurifil 50 wt. cotton thread, straight stitch around the edge of each tree.

Quilt your Timber Mini Quilt:

Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Pin together with safety pins, or baste together in preparation for quilting. I chose to quilt with straight lines, about 1/2" apart, using the walking foot on my sewing machine. Trim quilt to 18 x 24".

Cut three 2 1/2" strips from your binding fabric and bind your quilt. Enjoy!
