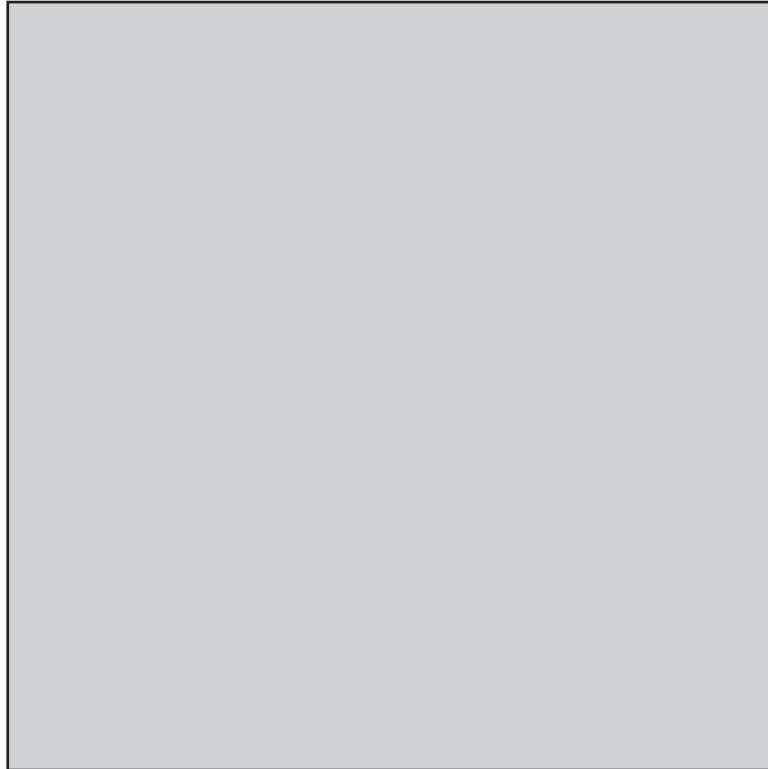

Print this page first.

The square shown above should measure 4" x 4".

Be sure you are printing at 100% size. Do not scale, re-size or 'Shrink to Fit'.

Your pattern may contain pattern pieces that will need to be taped together.
Locate the corresponding pattern pieces and tape together before cutting fabric.

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A New Direction - Block

General Instructions

Please read all the instructions first, it really does help.

Seams are 1/4"

Finger press seams open as you sew. Press without steam or water. There are lots of diagonal seams and this helps keep from stretching or shrinking.

Fabric Requirements

1/8 Yd Darker Fabric

1/8 Yd Lighter Fabric

Fat Quarter Background Fabric

Cut the Fabrics -

Paper Templates for cutting the pieces are provided, but we recommend a rotary cutter and mat.

If Using a 60 degree Ruler (We Recommend Creative Grids):

- Layer the paper template on the ruler as a guide if desired.
- Cut a 2 1/2" strip of fabric. Cut the 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" **pieces first**. Cut the remaining fabric to 2 1/4" wide then cut the triangles.
- Cut 5 3/4" strips from the background fabric for the larger triangles.

(1) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Rectangle (B)

Lighter Fabric

(2) Large Triangles (C)

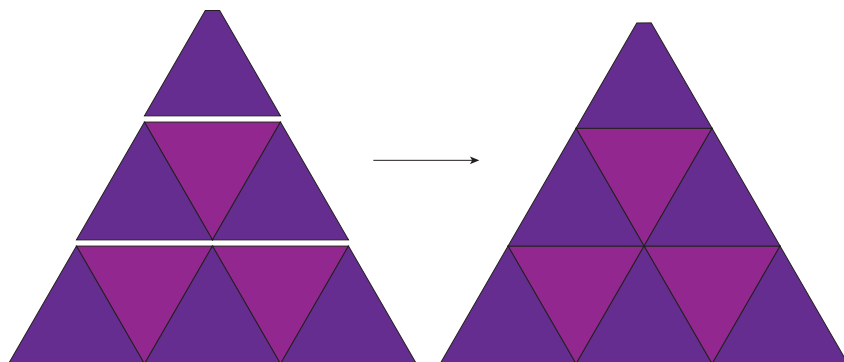
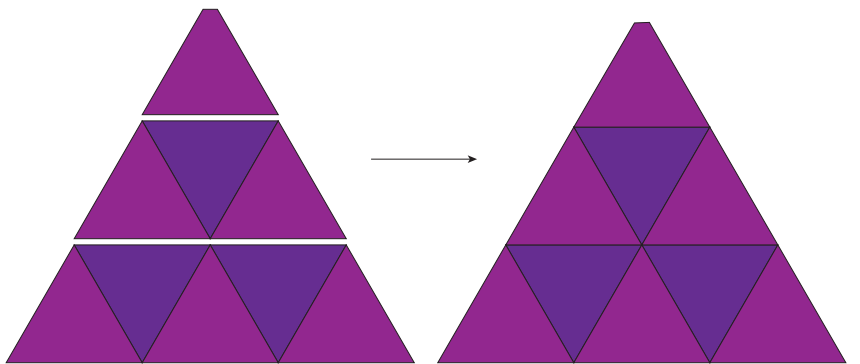
(2) Triangles (D)

(4) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" (B)

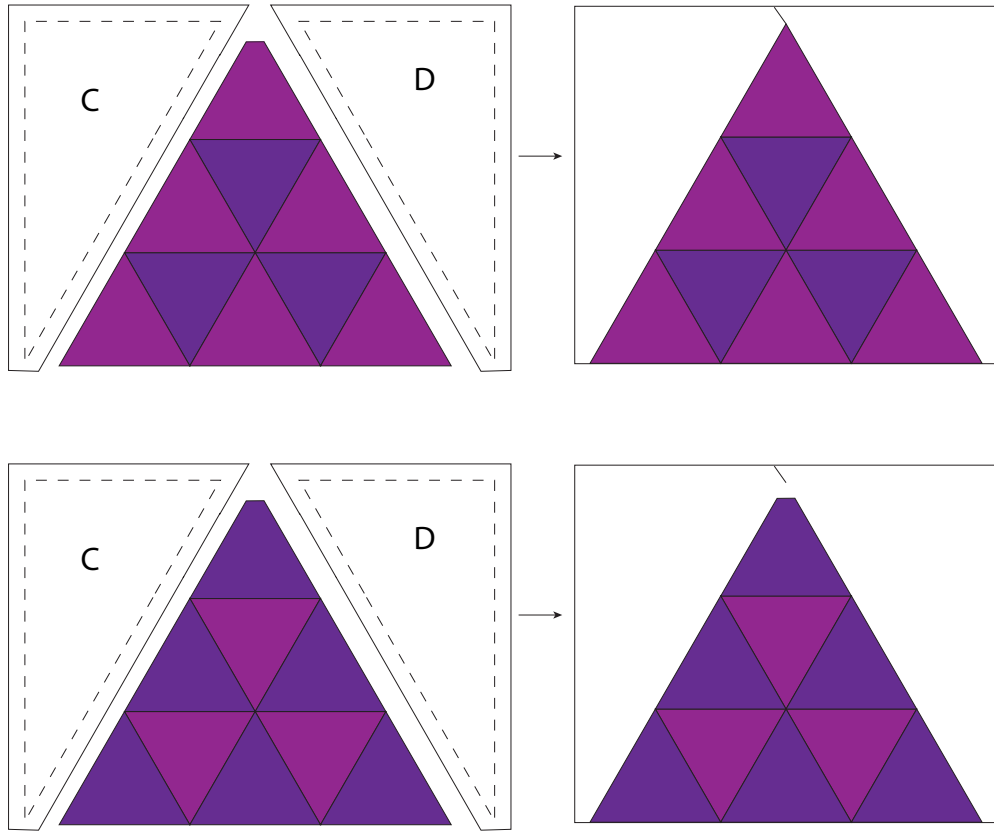
(2) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Rectangles (E)

Sew the Block

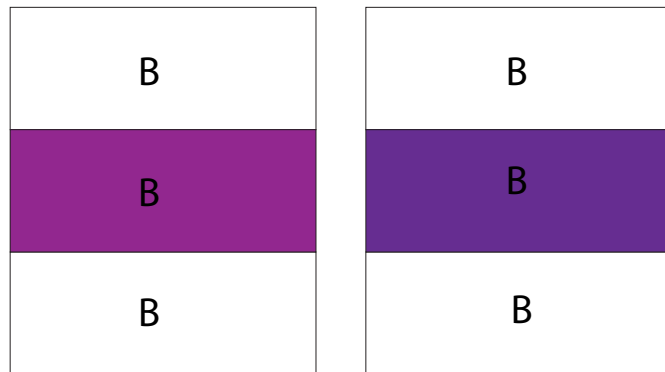
Sew the small (A) triangles together alternating colors. Finger press seams open. Sew one where the light color is dominate and sew one where the dark color is dominate.



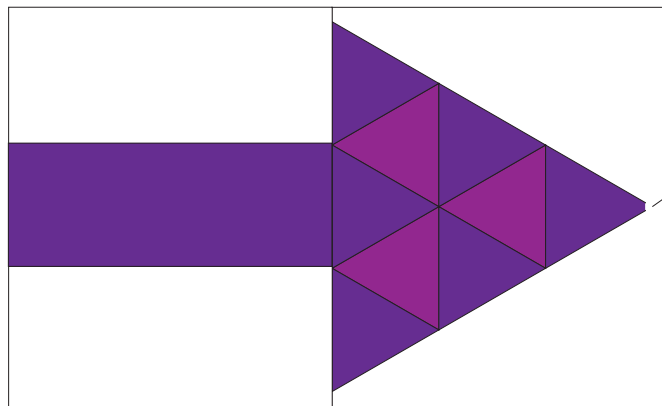
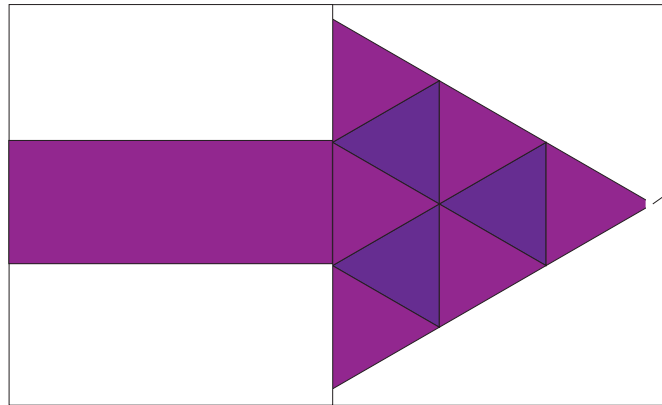
Sew the C and D rectangles to the sides of the triangles sewn in previous step. Press seams out.



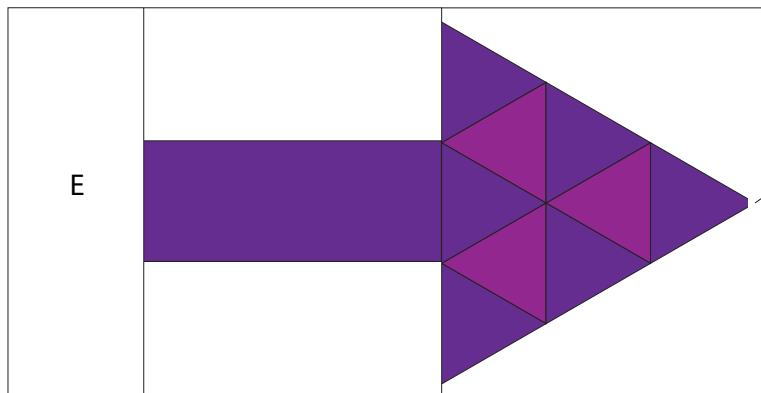
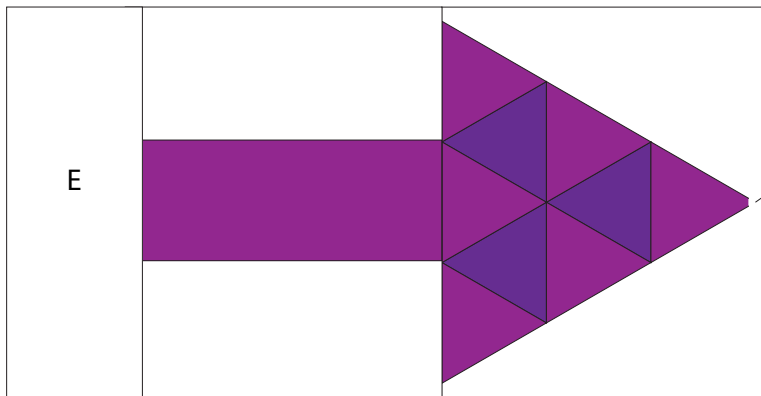
Sew the 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" B color and background rectangles together. Sew one light and one dark. Press seams open.



Sew the rectangle blocks to the triangle blocks to form an arrow. Press seams toward rectangle.



Sew the 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" (E) rectangle to the end of each block. Block should measure 12 1/2" x 6 1/2". Trim from the E side if needed. Press seams toward E.



Sew the two arrows together in opposite directions. Block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"
